Illinois Finance Authority 40101(d): Grid Resilience Grants



Program Overview

Under Section 40101(d) of the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, the U.S. Department of Energy is funding state grant programs to enhance electric grid resilience. The State of Illinois was awarded \$24 million for the first three years (FY2022, 2023 and 2024) of the five-year program. Information regarding the application process for the \$8 million allocated in FY2024 will be announced in the coming months.

The award is designed to strengthen and modernize Illinois' power grid and to provide a reliable power infrastructure to all communities to have access to affordable, reliable, and clean electricity.

Eligibility

Eligible Entities for subawards under this funding, include:

- Electric grid operators
- Electricity storage operators Distribution providers
- Transmission owners or operators
- Electricity generators
- Fuel suppliers
- · Other relevant entities

Funding

- The Illinois Climate Bank will distribute \$8 million, annually over a five-year period, prioritizing reliability, innovation, and disadvantaged communities.
- Federally funded grants range from \$150,000-\$8,000,000 per project and require a cost match from applicants.
- Cost match: The applicant will have to commit to match a percentage of all federal funds received for the project.
 - Small Utility: 48% cost match if the applicant sells less than 4,000,000 MWh per year
 - Large Utility: 115% cost match if the applicant sells more than 4,000,000 MWh per year
